SCALLOPING BEST PRACTICES



Develop
a safety plan
for your
group.

Always have
an observer
stay on board
while others are
scalloping.

Be aware
of changing
tides.

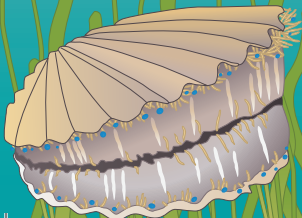


Snorkel with a buddy and stay within the required range of vessel.

DO NOT throw shells into a channel or canal, or dispose in waters near ramps.

Keep only scallops that are 1.5" or larger— throw anything smaller back.

Take down the dive flag before moving to another location.
