









Workshop Details The goal of this workshop is to make living shorelines permitting more approachable to a wider audience, not just experts. It is open to anyone with a basic knowledge of living shorelines who needs support with permitting, including consultants, homeowners, HOA officials, contractors, environmental managers, city/county staff, parks staff, and landscape professionals.
