

# Florida Clean & Resilient Marinas Small Grant Program



Florida Sea Grant is pleased to offer the Florida Clean & Resilient Marinas Small Grant Program. The goal of this grant program is to help marinas achieve new or renewed Florida [Clean Marina Program](#) designation. The small grant program will support the purchase of supplies to help marinas meet regulatory requirements or implement 60% of their voluntary Best Management Practices (BMPs) within the Clean Marina Action Plan.

## ELIGIBILITY

Grants are available to marinas that have received a favorable advisory site visit and are suitable for Clean Marina Designation by the end of 2027.

## FUNDING AVAILABILITY

Up to \$4,000 per grant. A total of \$15,000 is available. No more than one proposal may be submitted by an individual marina. This small grant program is made possible with funding by the Gulf of American Alliance and the NOAA Office for Coastal Zone Management.

## FUNDING LIMITATIONS

Funding may be used to purchase supplies that address the following BMPs:

- Petroleum/Fueling
- Hazardous Waste
- Recycled Liquid Waste
- Solid Waste
- Sensitive Habitats

Other supplies will be considered with justification. Florida Sea Grant will purchase the awarded supplies and have them shipped directly to the marina. The budget must include estimated shipping costs.

## APPROVAL

Approval of applications will be determined based on the completeness of the grant application, the marina's designation progress, relevance of the supplies to meeting designation, geographic location, budget, and the number of applications received.

## APPLICATION PROCESS & DEADLINES

Applications will be accepted through September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2026, or until funding has been expended. Complete applications must be emailed to Lisa Krimsky at [lkrimsky@ufl.edu](mailto:lkrimsky@ufl.edu). Notification of approval will occur on July 15<sup>th</sup> and October 15<sup>th</sup>.
